



Torres Isozaki

SPAIN

The complex is composed by two imposing twin towers, both 82 metres high and 23 floors, and 5 buildings between 6-8 floors.

Just a few metres from the Guggenheim museum, Fermax installed its door entry systems in the spectacular Torres Isozaki, one of the most modern buildings in Bilbao.

Designed by Japonese Architect Arata Isozaki, they have a total surface area of 84,000 square metres, of which 8,200m² is used for commercial activity, whilst the rest is used as housing that incorporate our intercom systems.

Palm Jumeirah DUBAI, UAE

The huge artificial island is an international symbol of leisure and an enormous residential destination with 1,800 Fermax door entry systems installed in its villas.

The biggest artificial island in the world, finished in 2008, has 5,6 km of space and a variety of different sized houses. 1,800 of the housing are villas and its promotors chose our video door entry systems' kits.





It is one of the tallest residential buildings in the world, almost 300 metres high.

It also has video door entry monitors in every apartment, with 7 door entry panels in different locations and 48 panels to control other accesses using proximity readers.





Uphill Court ISTANBUL

The most exclusive residence of the turkish city incorporates our door entry systems in its 4 accesses and its 1,800 apartments.

It is an exclusive residential complex surrounded by lots of green areas.


It uses the latest technology in its security systems.

Gran Luxor

This luxurious hotel of 4*+ of the Costa Blanca is located next to the theme park Terra Mítica, Alicante (Spain).

An exclusive complex of 300 great and luxury rooms with a terrace, 5 conference rooms, a Wellness&Health area including a new spa and a gym, 2 restaurants and large outdoor areas with pools and gardens.

The hotel is equipped with 200 CCTV cameras and 6 recorders with IP technology.





BelleVue Residences SINGAPORE

This residential complex by Toyoo Itō is close to nature. It has video door entry systems, access control and lift control systems from Fermax.

The luxurious complex is comprised of 197 apartments. Its clever architecture has been integrated into the nature.

The complex incorporates our intercom systems, integrating the fingerprint access control technology.

In order to use the private lifts to their apartments, the residents must use their fingerprint or a password.



Island Brygge COPENHAGEN

In the fashion suburb of the capital, this residential building has video door entry and access control systems at its entrances.

A building with 3 different entrances which incorporates access control systems. All 147 apartments have a Fermax door entry monitor. The neighbourhood was deteriorated in the past and after renovation it has converted into the most demanded residential area in the city.



Reflections SINGAPORE

More than 1,000 monitors installed.

Fermax is present in the first big residential project done by Daniel Libeskind in Asia It is both a residential and commercial complex situated in the maritime façade of the South of Singapore.

It is formed by 6 crystal towers between 24 and 41 floors that are mixed with 11 blocks between 6 to 8 floors. In total, there are 1,129 apartments incorporating our iLOFT video door entry monitors and LOFT telephones. It also has access control systems.



One The Elephant UNITED KINGDOM

Designed by award winning architects Squireo-Partners, recognised for its contemporary design in the traditional urban surroundings.

The 'One The Elephant' is distinguished by its principal architectural elements. Its slender and elegant tower of 37 floors with 254 houses in which there is an installation of VIVO monitors and a pavilion of 4 floors which include 30 houses.

The tower embody the best of the high standards, offering spectacular views of London, including Westminster Palace, Canary Wharf and the London Eye.





Etihad Towers ABU DHABI, UAE

In one of the best known projects in Abu Dhabi, we installed 500 monitors in the apartments of the Etihad Towers.

The curved figure of the tower represents a fluttering candle in the sea, in reference to the history of Abu Dhabi as a port.

A luxurious and modern complex, where there is a mix of residential, business and leisure facilities, built in a surface area 492,08 m². The 5 towers that comprise this complex are between 56 and 79 floors.
